<p>Subject: Use of Aircraft Storage Hangars</p>	

This policy provides the requirements of general aviation aircraft tenants for the use of hangars at the Airports designated for the storage of aircraft. This policy addresses and ensures compliance with the sublease or aviation association sublease agreements and addresses consistency with the FAA policies on the proper use of airport hangars.

Aeronautical uses for aircraft storage hangars include:

- Storage of active aircraft.
- Non-commercial construction of amateur-built or kit-built aircraft.
- Maintenance, repair, or refurbishment of aircraft, but not the indefinite storage of nonoperational aircraft.

Hangars must be used for aeronautical activities, however:

- Non-aeronautical items may be stored in hangars provided the hangar is used primarily for aeronautical purposes and the items do not interfere with the aeronautical use of the hangar.

Hangar storage cannot:

- Impede the movement of the aircraft in and out of the hangar or impede access to aircraft or other aeronautical contents out of the hangar.
- Displace the aeronautical contents out of the hangar. A vehicle parked at the hangar while the vehicle owner is using the aircraft will not be considered to displace the aircraft.
- Impede access to aircraft or other aeronautical contents of the hangar.
- Store items or conduct activity in violation of Airport rules and regulations, lease provisions, building codes, or local ordinances.

Hangar uses not permitted:

- Hangars may not be used as a residence (of any length of stay).
- Business uses contrary to the lease agreement.
- Primary storage of non-aircraft items.

The Commission staff will perform periodical inspections to ensure compliance with this policy.
